

Baby Safety Month

How many times have you caught your child some place they shouldn't be? Several of you. We need to remember a few tips:

Parents! Do the following:

1. Keep small objects like marbles, balloons, balls, coins, and small toys off the floor and away from children.
2. Little ones should not be playing with toys made for older kids.
3. Follow labels that give age recommendations.
4. Teach and continually remind older children to keep their toys away from younger siblings.
5. Check stuffed animals and toys for small loose parts.
6. Secure dressers, shelves, and televisions to the wall so they do not fall over.
7. Keep beds away from the window & do not use blinds with cords.
8. Put all medication and cleaning supplies in a locked cabinet.
9. Cover all outlets so a child not put anything in it.
10. Do not leave the child alone in the bath tub.
11. Make sure they are strapped in when they travel.
12. Remember: if it looks dangerous to you, it will look fun to your child.
